ARRIVAL

- Please make sure your child is on time, in line, each morning by the time the bell rings at 7:50am
- If your child is late, he/she must go to the office to check in
- Per the Student/Parent Handbook: If your child is tardy more than 5 times in a trimester, parents will be charged \$20 for every tardy thereafter

& DISMISSAL

- I will walk students to the lunch tables at 2:45 Mon-Thurs, and 12:15 on Fridays
- If your child is not picked up by 3 o'clock (or 12:30 on Friday), your child will be placed in daycare at your expense (this is for your child's safety)



UNIFORM

- Boys should wear a belt each day, with their shirts tucked in.
- Girls' hair accessories should be kept minimal, with no large bows/ears
- Students may wear their PE uniform on Wednesdays for Yoga, and Fridays for PE



GLASS DOJO

- We will be using ClassDojo to monitor positive student behavior
- Students are awarded points for displaying positive behaviors such as:
 - being on task
 - showing respect
 - working hard
 - helping others
- ClassDojo can be viewed from home computer/phone app in real time
- Negative behaviors, such as
 - being off task
 - showing disrespect to teacher/peers will result in Dojo point deduction after multiple reminders, and repeated negative behaviors will result in a notice sent home for parent signature



DOJO REWARDS

- Student ClassDojo points accumulate throughout 1 week
- Each Friday, students will redeem their Dojo points for a reward from the classroom "Dojo Store"
- Dojo Store rewards vary based upon the number of points a student has earned throughout the week

Rewards include:

- a small candy
- a small toy/prize
- sit by a friend for the day
- · sit in the teacher's chair for the day
- Bring 1 item for show and tell
- Eat lunch with the teacher
- Use the Teacher's Pen for the day
- Pick 1 GoNoodle video for the class
- Free Homework Pass



 Math and Reading tests will be given as we complete the unit, typically not on a Friday



- Homework will include Spelling, Math, and Reading practice
- Homework packet will be sent home each Monday and is to be returned each day to be checked and sent home to complete the next day's assignment
- If your child has earned a Homework Pass from Dojo Store, they may use it on any 1 night of their choosing to skip all parts of that night's homework



TESTS

- Each Friday, students will have a Spelling test, Phonics test, and (occasionally) Vocabulary test; which will assess the skills learned throughout the week
- Math and Reading tests will be given as we complete the unit, typically not on a Friday



MATH FACTS

- Students will take a math fact fluency test about once a week, for the entire school year.
- We will begin with completing 25 addition facts in 2 minutes, and increase to 50 addition facts in 3.5 minutes, and reach 100 addition facts in 5 minutes by the end of the school year
- This same pattern occurs with subtraction facts, which begin near the halfway mark of the school year
- You can help your child succeed by timing their math fact homework, and practicing with flashcards at home



GRADELINK

- Grades are inputted within 5 days of taking the test or completing classwork
- Please keep up to date with your child's progress via Gradelink, so there are no surprises come report card day.
